



ACCEPTANCE OF THE CONDITIONS OF REGISTRATION FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE NEW ZEALAND MPI SEED VARIETAL CERTIFICATION SCHEME

Before signing this form, you are ADVISED TO CAREFULLY READ the following terms and conditions which apply to all growers of certified seed. These terms and conditions impose legal obligations on growers and consequent liability in the event of failure to meet these obligations. If the Grower or you feel these obligations cannot be met, please do not enter crops for seed varietal certification.

2	Authorisation – I declare that I am authorised to sign this acceptance form on behalf of the Grower. Instructions – I declare that I have read the MPI Certification Standard: Seed Varietal Certification Requirements (including Appendix 1 & 2) and agree to comply with the standards and procedures published therein. [The Certification Standards can be accessed on MPI's website: http://www.mpi.govt.nz/exporting/plants/grain-and-seeds-for-sowing/requirements/]				
3	Supply of Information – I declare that all information supplied in the Grower's Application - New Zealand MPI Seed Varieta Certification Scheme form and any other written or oral information supplied to AsureQuality Limited (AsureQuality) in relation to the production of seed for varietal certification is correct in all respects.				
4	Paddock History – I acknowledge that accurate paddock history information for all crops sown on an area intended for producir certified seed must be supplied. I acknowledge that any failure to provide accurate records will result in the area/crop becomir ineligible for certification.				
5	Harvesting of Seed – The Grower agrees that all of the Grower's seed crops entered into certification will not be harvested until such time as they have received written confirmation from AsureQuality that the crop(s) in question have been inspected. I acknowledge that any crop harvested prior to receiving confirmation of inspection will result in the harvested crop becoming non-certified. [Crop Field Inspection results and a copy of your Certificate of Identification for each officially inspected crop are available via eSeedCert at: https://eseedcert.asurequality.com/harvest/ .]				
6	Identification of Seed – The Grower will maintain the identity of all seed lots eligible for MPI Seed Varietal Certification and will identify each seed lot harvested with the correct labels supplied by AsureQuality. In addition, I acknowledge that any seed lot to be sown that is not identified with the correct MPI certified labels at the time of purchase, during delivery or storage, will lose its certification status and therefore cannot be entered into the MPI Seed Varietal Certification Scheme.				
7	Adulteration of Seed – The Grower will not, in respect of seed to be sown or harvested, add to or substitute seed of any other variety which will adulterate or otherwise change the certified seed lot. Furthermore, the Grower agrees to supply the required information (including official MPI reference numbers) for <u>all</u> seed sown when applying for entry into the MPI Seed Varietal Certification Scheme.				
8	Subcontractors and Transportation – The Grower accepts responsibility for ensuring all machinery and equipment used during the sowing, harvesting and transportation of certified seed is clean and not contaminated with other seed.				
9	Access – The Grower permits any person authorised by MPI, access at reasonable times to areas, crops, machinery, plant, storage facilities or any other item used in the production of seed intended for varietal certification.				
10	Information access – The Grower agrees to the Variety Owner, Breeder, or Breeder's Agent (head licensee) having access to data on relevant Varieties entered into the New Zealand MPI Seed Varietal Certification Scheme.				
11	Late fees – I acknowledge that ALL applications must be received IN FULL at the Seed Certification Bureau, Palmerston North, prior to the closing date for each relevant species and acknowledge that all entries received after this date will incur a late fee.

12	The Grower agrees that any failure to comply with the requirements specified in the New Zealand MPI Seed Varietal Certification Scheme, could result both in losses to third parties, and third-party claims against MPI and AsureQuality. The Grower agrees that such claims and losses are reasonably foreseeable as not unlikely to result from their failure to comply with the requirements and should therefore be recoverable by MPI and AsureQuality against them.				
13	Cancellation of registration - Where any of the terms and conditions above are breached or negligently performed by the Grower, AsureQuality may, after consulting with MPI and after considering any submissions made in writing by the Grower, cancel that Grower's registration in the New Zealand MPI Seed Varietal Certification Scheme.
