#### Sampling

Submit up to 10 leaves or 25 roots per clean/new plastic bag, making sure not to cross contaminate sub samples.

1. Samples should be kept cool at all times. Courier in chilly bin with ice pack. Separate samples from ice pack to avoid frost damage to samples.
2. If necessary, tubers will be sprouted until suitable leaves have developed for tests. This may take several months.
3. For sample sizes for export, consult the Importing Country Phytosanitary Requirements (ICPRs)
4. Meristem plantlets are grown-on in a green house and each plantlet will be tested individually.
